

# GENERAL+ MAP 1



## INFORMACIÓN + GENERAL

#### **ACCREDITATION**

Accreditations can be collected at the designated tables in front of the Covadonga museum (near the roundabout). Each person will have to wear his accreditation in a visible place during the JEMJ.

The accreditation is necessary to collect food packs, get access to the Eucharistic workshops, access to accommodation and other events of the JEMJ.

In case you find an accreditation that is not yours, please hand it in at the Lost and Found tent.

#### **TRANSLATIONS**

English translations will be available during the conference.

Each participant who needs it must have a mobile phone and headphones to be able to listen to the translation.

For more information on how to connect to the translations, please visit the translation table at the welcome desk.

#### **ALLERGIES**

Please remember that there will be no special food packs for people with allergies or intolerances.

Whoever needs to avail of it, there is a restaurant in Covadonga, or you could bring food from home.

During the time of Communion at Mass there will be a place marked by a red umbrella where celiacs can receive Communion.

#### **FOOD**

Each group or person will be assigned on their acreditation one of the 8 spots where the food packs are distributed.

Participants can pick up their pack ONLY in the assigned spot.

We recommend that only one or two representatives of the group come to the booth to pick up the food for the whole group.

There will be no special food packs for people with allergies or intolerances.

Whoever needs to avail of it, there is a restaurant in Covadonga, or you could bring food from home.

To avoid food waste, we have installed specific containers where you can deposit the food from the pack that you know you will not eat.

Please DO NOT THROW FOOD AWAY.

#### **WORKSHOPS**

JEMJ offers 5 different Eucharistic workshops to help you deepen your faith and love for Jesus in the Eucharist.

Participants will have previously chosen the workshop they wish to attend through the website. If they have not done so, they will be randomly assigned according to the number of spots available.

The workshop will be indicated on the accreditation, which is needed to get in.

The workshops to choose from are:

#### **EUCHARIST AND PASSION**

Do you know all that the Shroud has revealed about Jesus? Jorge Manuel Rodríguez Almenar, doctor in Art History and president of the Spanish Center of Sindonology, will reveal all the details of the Passion of Jesus, and we will see its relationship with the Eucharist.

#### Q&A - ASK AN EXPERT: FR. FÉLIX LÓPEZ, SHM

Are you embarrassed to defend your faith because you have no arguments to answer? Are you bored at Mass? In the workshop "Questions and Answers" you will be able to express all of your doubts about the faith, the Eucharist, etc.

In response, you'll get answers to help you be well formed and able to give witness in your life.

#### VALIVÁN

Vale and José are part of a family completely dedicated to evangelization. Become like a child and let yourself be surprised with Valiván. They will awaken in you the freshness of love for God and the Virgin Mary through Renata and Leopoldo, the characters they bring to life.

#### WAKE UP! THE PERSECUTED CHURCH AND THE EUCHARIST

Inflame your heart and soul by learning about the experiences of those who live and die each day for witnessing to Jesus Christ. You'll hear from a diocesan priest, Fr. Wenceslao Blem, and a missionary priest of the Institute of the Incarnate Word, Fr. Rodrigo Miranda. Jesus is alive in the Eucharist in places of persecution.

#### THE RECONQUEST: FROM COVADONGA TO HOLLYWOOD

Evangelization through the media.

Over the centuries, the Catholic Church has influenced society through art and culture. Fr. Brian Jackson, SHM, and director of the "Catholic Stuff" channel will talk about how to reconquer the MEDIA for Jesus Christ.

#### **BUSES**

The bus company ALSA has buses that go up from Cangas de Onís to the Covadonga sanctuary for those who wish.

The organization of the JEMJ will also provide two shuttle buses that will cover the route between Cangas de Onís and Arriondas during the whole event. Be attentive to the announcements with the shuttle bus schedules.

#### **INFORMATION**

The Information point available for any need you may have during the encounter is located next to the statue of Don Pelayo.

#### LOST AND FOUND

In case you lose something or find a lost object, you can go to the Lost and Found section in the Information Booth.

#### **JEMJ T-SHIRT**

If you purchased an official JEMJ t-shirt, you can collect it when you pick up your badge.

#### DRESS ETIQUETTE

Out of respect for this sacred place, for the events in which we are going to participate and for all JEMJ participants—religious and laity—we should dress appropriately, decently and with dignity. This applies especially in the liturgical acts, as well as in the tents and other lodgings, bathrooms and shower areas, etc. We ask that modesty is always observed throughout the Covadonga area.

(No low-cut tops, shoulders should be covered, and trousers or skirts should be at least down to the knee).

#### **MASS**

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. All the good of the Church is enclosed in the Eucharist, since it is God Himself whom we receive. Therefore, we ask for a full and respectful participation in all JEMJ Masses. In order to receive Communion, the following conditions are necessary:

- Keep the Eucharistic fast (do not eat or drink 1 hour before communion)
- Be in a state of grace (not being conscious of having committed a mortal sin after your last well-made confession)
- Believe that you are receiving Jesus Christ Himself.

If you do not fulfill these requirements, you cannot receive Communion, but are invited to participate in the Mass with your presence and prayer.

If you are not in the state of grace, you can not receive Communion intil you have made a god confession.

We ask that your respect for the Eucharist is also shown in the way you dress and in your behavior during the celebration (posture, silence, etc.).

During the time of Communion, there will be volunteers with white umbrellas who will indicate the places where the ministers will be distributing communion.

For celiacs there will be a place marked by a red umbrella where they can receive Communion.

#### **CONFESSION**

A good confession can be one of the most important keys to a good JEMJ experience.

Priests will be available for confession throughout the JEMJ in the park next to the esplanade and inside the basilica.

During the adoration turns that will be held from Saturday night to Sunday in the Holy Cave there will be priests confessing for those who wish to do so.

We recommend going over the examination of conscience.

## **HEALTH** + SAFETY

#### **HEALTH CENTER**

The closest health center to the Sanctuary of Covadonga is the Health Center of Cangas de Onis.

It is open Monday - Sunday from 8:00 - 15:00 and from 16:30-20:00.

Any health emergency outside these hours should be directed to 112. In the enclosure of the sanctuary, there is health care for those who need it. It is located between the Museum building and the Escolania.

#### **SECURITY**

The security team is in charge of helping maintain a calm and orderly atmosphere throughout the JEMJ and will be ready to help as needed.

They will be identified with green hi-vis vests. If you see suspicious or out-of-place activity, please notify the security team to resolve the situation.

In order for the event to run smoothly, we ask that you listen to directions and follow what the MCs, volunteers and security team advise.

#### **VOLUNTEERS**

The JEMJ volunteers will be identified with a green hi-vis vest and the youth volunteers can be identified by a blue vi-vis vest. Do not hesitate to ask them for help, they are there to help with whatever you need.

#### **FIRST AID**
